leaves float.



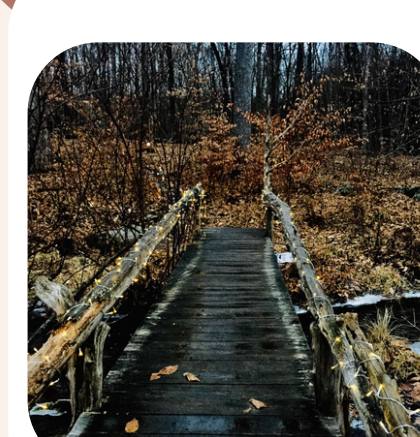
A place to
